Student Behavior Code

Curfew: Students are expected to be back in the lodge after the evening meal unless participating in a supervised group activity. Normally by 9:00 p.m. everyone should be in the lodge. Most Colorado towns have a curfew of 10:00 p.m. In consideration of other guests staying at the lodge, you are expected to clear the halls and be in your room by 10:00 p.m. At 12:00 midnight, the trip leader will check each condo to make sure all rooms are quiet. The desk clerk will call the trip leader if there are any complaints of noise in Resurrection rooms.

Money and Identification: Carry your money, I.D. and valuables with you at all times. Church of the Resurrection is not responsible for lost items.

Drugs and Alcohol: Use of, possession of, alcohol or any type of drug other than prescription drugs will not be tolerated. Should a chaperone have cause to believe this rule has, is, or is about to be broken, we reserve the right to examine or search for alcohol or drugs. Offenders will be sent home at the earliest possible time and at his or her parents own expense.

Unacceptable Behavior: It is impossible for us to provide constant supervision while on the mountain. It is also impossible for us to list all types of inappropriate behavior. Anything inconsistent with the beliefs or values of the High School Youth Group is considered inappropriate. Students on the trip are expected to use good judgment in their personal conduct; otherwise parents will be contacted.

I have read the Student Behavior Code and agree to abide by it. I support Church of the Resurrection's effort to provide a safe, organized, well chaperoned ski trip and agree with the spirit and intent of the Student Behavior Code. I also agree to conform to and abide by the rules of the ski resort.
